

The Gambia:

This tiny sliver of Africa's smallest country is wedged into surrounding Senegal, and is seen as a splinter in its side.



The Gambia is a country with beaches that invite visitors to enjoy and to relax. But there's more than sun and surf. Colourfull markets, fishing villages and nature reserves are all within easy reach. The Gambia is a nature- and a bird lovers' paradise: you'll easily spot more than 100 species.

Organization:

There are weekly flights every Saturday to Banjul from Barcelona (Vueling), Gran Canaria (Binter Canarias) and some other European destinacions. You have to book your flights yourself.

Very important: You have to have a passport! YOUR PASSPORT HAS TO BE VALID FOR AT LEAST 6 MONTHS after arrival date.

For a stay of less than 28 days travellers get the visa at the entry into The Gambia. You will have to fill in a form, which they give you in the airplane or at the airport in Banjul. (keep a pen or a pencil in your hand-bag)



National currency is the "Dalasi". Money can be changed at the hotel/lodge.

Health:

Vaccines for HepatitisA, Tetanus and Typhoid are recommended for travellers visiting The Gambia.

Winter in Gambia is dry season. So there are no mosquitoes around at the coastal areas, but travellers visiting The Gambia are always at risk of catching MALARIA.

Please inform yourself or ask me and make your own decision.

Travellers should always have a bottle of drinking-water with them.
