

The Gambia:

Organization:

You have to book the flight yourself, i can only advise you.

To Banjul there are flights with Brussels Airlines, TAP Portugal, Air France, Vueling and others.

There are also possibilities to come with Royal Air Maroc via Casablanca or from Gran Canaria with Binter Canarias.

Very important: You have to have a passport!
YOUR PASSPORT HAS TO BE VALID FOR AT LEAST 6 MONTHS after arrival date.

For a stay of less than 28 days travellers get the visa at the entry into The Gambia.

You will have to fill in a form, which they give you in the airplane or at the airport in Banjul.

(keep a pen or a pencil in your hand-bag)

We will pick you up at the airport of Banjul, from then on we will take care of you.



Health:

Vaccines for HepatitisA, Tetanus and Typhoid are recommended for travellers visiting The Gambia.

Winter in Gambia is dry season. So there are no mosquitoes around at the coastal areas, but travellers visiting The Gambia are always at risk of catching MALARIA.

Please inform yourself or ask me and make your own decision.

Thes same goes for Covid. Currently a valid test is only required for not-vaccinated people to enter the country.

Only at the airport, at the bank and in some offices it is mandatory to wear a mask.
