



Jinak-Island

Jinack Island is located north of the Gambia River estuary.

It is separated from the mainland by the Niji Bolon.

There are no roads on Jinack Island, with the only transport options to travel by donkey, bike or on foot.

As part of the Niimi National Park the island is perfect for nature lovers and birdwatchers with over 500 species of birds.

Soft sand beaches and gently lapping shallow seas make the island perfect for beach walking, wading and paddling or just lazing in the sun.



Jinak-Lodge

Eco-lodge with solar power, located on an almost deserted beachfront, facing the Atlantic Ocean.

It has 4 double and single bedroom huts, each with an ensuite shower, wash-hand basin and toilet.

The lodge also has a restaurant and bar service, and has set up a few hammocks on the beach.
